Instructions for Use — Children's Swim Belt ("Hedgehog") Designed for teaching infants and toddlers how to swim

1. Purpose of the Product

The swim belt is a swimming aid used for teaching basic swimming skills to infants and toddlers. It helps the child stay afloat and supports the development of a positive relationship with water.

2. Choosing the Correct Size

The swim belt must be selected based on the child's current body weight. Sizes are designed to correspond to different weight categories. Only the correct size ensures proper buoyancy and safe use of the swimming aid.

3. Product Description

- Consists of several floating foam segments ("hedgehogs") threaded onto a nylon strap
- The strap is equipped with a safety buckle for easy fastening around the child's waist
- The number of foam segments can be adjusted to increase or decrease buoyancy as needed

4. Instructions for Use

- 1. Check the condition of the belt make sure the foam pieces are undamaged and the buckle works properly.
- 2. Place the belt around the child's waist it should sit slightly above the hips when in the water.
- 3. Fasten the buckle and ensure it clicks securely into place.
- 4. Adjust the strap length as needed so the belt fits snugly but does not constrict.
- 5. Hold the child in the water and observe their movements. If buoyancy is too high or too low, add or remove foam segments accordingly.

5. Important Warnings and Safety Instructions

- NEVER leave a child unattended not even for a moment!
- The swim belt is **not a life-saving device** and **does not replace adult supervision**.
- Always check the condition of the swimming aid before use.
- The swimming aid is **intended for use in water only**, not on land.

6. Care and Storage

- Rinse with clean water after use, especially if used in chlorinated pools.
- Allow to air dry do not expose to direct sunlight or heat sources.
- Store in a dry and well-ventilated place.
- Protect from mechanical damage and prolonged exposure to direct sunlight.
